The closest airport to the hotel is Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA). The hotel's complimentary shuttle will be available to and from the airport.

The other area airports are Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD) & Baltimore Washington International Airport (BWI). The hotel shuttle does not go to those airports. You will need to either use Uber, Lyft, taxi, a car rental, or the Metrorail.

For those who will be driving to the area, you will need to enter the hotel's main entrance located on S. Eads St. between 15th St. S. & 18th St. S. Another landmark is Crystal Towers which is across the street from Crystal Gateway Marriott entrance and The Westin hotel is next to the Crystal Gateway Marriott.
